We believe this project will facilitate personal growth of the volunteer, making them more independent and self-confident, ready to take initiative and bring ideas into life.

We aim to provide the volunteer opportunities to realise her/her own ideas and aspirations in action through working with the youth. Volunteer main activities in our organisation will include:

- Working with the youngsters and children in our NGO and other organisations of IZUM centre as ABC school, as well as our local partners (other NGOs and schools);
- Working in urban and suburban camps during school holidays;
- Teaching English/native language and leading events on introducing culture to the local youth and anyone interested;
- Organising and taking part in various projects, workshops, events, entertainment activities together with youngsters;
- Leading workshops on different topics, all developed by herself with help of NGO staff.
- Take initiative and realize own ideas in action (write own local project, organise events for children or other entertainment).
- The main focus of work will be in the Youth Club Active centre, where volunteer will try first-hand the methods of non-formal education. The personal timetable will be created in accordance with her/his needs and desires, but it will be flexible and

available for revisions, if needed. We will give to volunteer a workload of no more than 36 hours per week.

Volunteer will be provided with a tutor and mentor from our NGO. Mentor for volunteer will be provided during the project. Tutor Darja Djatsenko will organise evaluation meetings with volunteer every month.

The programme could be very flexible, everything will depend on the volunteer's wishes and power. We are open to any initiative of the volunteer. The timetable will be flexible as well because of different projects and activities of Youth Club Active organisation. We are ready to support our volunteers in all beginnings.

Furthermore, every month the volunteer will be offered to fill in the YouthPass certificate competences. It could help to reflect and evaluate his/her YCF project. The volunteer will have the opportunity to participate in different projects, events and performances offered by the tutor.
